

On - Site Saw Bench with Dust Management Controls



A well planned site saw bench set up goes a long way to providing a safe place of work for those who use it. Good cable management, waste disposal bins and good housekeeping prevents incidents such as slips trips and falls. When possible physical barriers should be erected to prevent others from entering the work area particularly when high levels of dust being generated



Wearing the correct PPE and having the correct exhaust ventilation on the saw is essential for providing a dust free environment for the joiner when cutting wood and other products

There are many types of respirator or dust masks to consider when cutting different materials on site with the correct one being established through risk assessment. Whatever type chosen it is essential that the individual using be given a face fit test to ensure it is being worn and used correctly
